General Accountability:

Patriot Battery Metals is a hard-rock lithium exploration company focused on advancing its district-scale discovery at the 100% owned Corvette Property, located proximal to the Trans-Taiga Road in the traditional territory of the Cree Nation of Chisasibi, in the Eeyou Istchee James Bay Region of Québec.

This position will provide full-time Environmental Technician support to our Exploration Camp. The individual will ensure that all site practices comply with Québec regulatory requirements. The position works alongside the on-site Project Manager and reports to the Principal Environment. PMET offers a competitive salary.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Ensure all PMET environmental policies and procedures are implemented and on-site activities are in compliance with environmental regulations
- Provide daily guidance and direction on environmental programs at the site level to ensure a common and effective approach
- Maintain Safe Operating Practices (SOPs) for all environmental management procedures and utilize them in daily worker training
- Provide on-site support for environmental permit applications and environmental baseline field programs

Drinking water and wastewater monitoring

- Establish and implement water sampling program to ensure target parameters are met
- Maintain regular record keeping of water quality sampling results
- Trouble shooting and maintenance of water treatment container systems

Waste management and reduction

- Establish and implement a domestic and hazardous waste reduction program
- Monitor on site waste streams to optimize segregation and reduce handling costs
- Provide worker training on hazardous material handling
- Ensure all activities are in compliance with regulations
- Establish regular domestic and hazardous waste pick up schedule

Spill reporting and management

- Provide on-site support for the prevention of spills or environmental releases;
- Report all spills to the regulatory authorities, as required;
- Review environmental incidents / spills and conduct field audits; and manage corrective actions;
- Assist with maintaining the Site Preparedness and Emergency Plans & Procedures;
- Maintain filing systems regarding environmental permits, compliance and spills/incidents;

Drill site selection and inspections

- Perform environmental inspections at remote proposed and active drill sites
- Assist in siting of drill pads to minimize environmental impacts and ensure regulatory compliance
- Oversee drill pad and trail rehabilitation.

The above duties and responsibilities are representative of the nature and level of work assigned and are not necessarily all-inclusive.

Working Conditions

- Physical ability to lift 50 lbs;
- Fly in/fly out rotational shift work (2 week on/off);
- Accommodation and travel are provided;
- Manual dexterity required to use laptop/desktop computer;
- On call capabilities outside of regular work schedule, as required;
- Ability to stand and walk for long periods of time, up to 12 hours;
- Comfort driving a pick-up truck on remote logging roads;
- Comfort driving a snowmobile on an established winter trail;
