About the job:

Patriot Battery Metals (PMET) is a hard-rock lithium exploration company focused on advancing its district-scale Corvette Property located in the Eeyou Istchee James Bay region of Quebec, Canada.

This position is based at the Exploration Camp located at kilometer 270 on the Trans-Taiga highway. The role is to represent Patriot Battery Metals at the Corvette Site, manage and coordinate common site services and provide leadership for the Corvette Health, Safety and Environmental (HSE) programs.

Ideally you will have a strong background in remote camp management for mining projects with experience in managing camp operations and maintenance contracts.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Manage the contracts for Corvette common site services including but not limited to camp management, camp maintenance and site logistics.
- Manage the budget and forecast for camp operations and maintenance in conjunction with the Vice President of Project Development.
- Manage the interfaces with regulatory agencies, local government and other companies operating in the area.
- Ensure implementation of the Corvette Asset Management plan including the maintenance program for the camp, small capital projects for upgrades and improvements and support the Project Development team with oversight of larger capital projects.
- Provide leadership for emergency response, incident investigations, audits and inspections and risk reviews and analysis for the Corvette Project.

Education and Training:

- Minimum of five years' experience in a Site Management and/or Camp Management role.
- Minimum of five years total mining experience would be an asset.
- Experience in service contract management is a benefit.
- Experience with HSE management is a benefit.
- Minimum Intermediate First Aid.
- Previous experience working with First Nation communities is an asset.
- Intermediate computer skills (e.g. MS Office including Excel and Word) are essential.
- Valid Class 5 driver's license.
- Bilingualism (French and English).
- Must have full working rights in Canada.

Working Conditions

- Fly in/fly out positions based at the Exploration Camp with rotational shifts of 2 weeks on/2 weeks off.

- Physical ability to lift 50 lbs.
- Travel and remote camp work as required.
- Manual dexterity required to use laptop/desktop computer.
- On call capabilities outside of regular work schedule, as required.
- Ability to stand and walk for long periods of time, up to 12 hours.
- Comfort driving a vehicle on remote logging roads.
- Comfort driving a snowmobile on an established winter trail.
