

Maintenance Supervisor

About the job:

Patriot Battery Metals (PMET) is a hard-rock lithium exploration company focused on advancing its district-scale Corvette Property located in the Eeyou Istchee James Bay region of Quebec, Canada.

This position is based at the Exploration Camp located at kilometer 270 on the Trans-Taiga highway. The role is to lead the maintenance and repair activities at the Shaakichiuwaanaan Exploration Camp located at kilometer 270 on the Trans-Taiga highway.

The camp has a capacity of 88 persons and includes 2 dormitories, kitchen/dining complex, offices and administration facilities, recreation area, laundry, contractor offices and mine dry. The camp systems include 500kW electrical generators and electrical distribution, potable water well, treatment plant and distribution system, wastewater collection system, treatment plant and effluent outfall, propane system, furnaces, water heaters, fire systems including hoses, extinguishers and alarms, internet and radio communication systems, kitchen ventilation. This role would also have responsibility for arranging the maintenance and repair of the Company's mobile fleet which includes light vehicles, ATV's, snow mobiles and small earth moving equipment. The role reports to the Site Manager.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Carry out maintenance and repair activities at the Shaakichiuwaanaan Exploration Camp.
- Arrange and supervise work by contractors on the Shaakichiuwaanaan Exploration Camp systems.
- Support the Site Manager in developing and implementing a maintenance plan for all camp systems including spare part acquisition, storage and management, routine maintenance planning and execution, regular internal and regulatory inspections.

Education and Training:

- Minimum of five years' experience working on camp utility systems in a remote cold weather environment.
- Trade qualification and license is an asset.
- Knowledge of applicable Health and Safety and camp construction legislation is an asset.
- Previous experience working with First Nation communities is an asset.
- Intermediate computer skills (e.g. MS Office including Excel and Word).
- Valid Class 5 driver's license
- Bilingualism (French and English) is an asset.
- Must have full working rights in Canada.

Working Conditions

- Fly in/fly out position based at the Exploration Camp with rotational shifts of 2 weeks on/2 weeks off.
- Physical ability to lift 50 lbs.
- Travel and work in a remote camp environment.
- Manual dexterity required to use laptop/desktop computer.
- On call capabilities outside of regular work schedule, as required.
- Ability to stand and walk for long periods of time, up to 12 hours.
- Comfort driving a vehicle on remote logging roads.
- Comfort driving a snowmobile on an established winter trail.
